Requirements and Directions:

1. Minor programs require a minimum of 18 credits. (PASSHE)
2. The minor shall have a minimum of 6 credits from SRU. (SRU)
3. The minor shall have a minimum of 6 upper division credits at the 300/400 level (PASSHE)
4. A student may not elect the pass/fail grading option for courses in a minor. (SRU)
5. Courses counted in a minor can also be used to satisfy Liberal Studies/Rock Studies requirements. (SRU)
6. At least 6 credits in the minor shall be outside the requirements/electives counted in the student's major. (SRU)
7. A student must earn at least a 2.0 or higher in the minor. The GPA requirement may vary by minor.
8. Students may not add, complete or declare a minor after graduation. The requirements for all minors must be completed prior to the awarding of the first baccalaureate degree. Once graduated, a student may not return and add additional minors to their undergraduate record. (SRU)
9. Students must be aware that since the minor must be completed simultaneously with a major degree program, any outstanding minor requirements will prevent the awarding of the degree for your major. If you ultimately decide to graduate without the minor, the minor must be removed from your record before your degree can be processed. The student will need to complete this form or notify the Office of Academic Records and Registration in writing to officially drop the minor.
